3. Their written work echoed the fact that most inner expression is done through mother tongue and that it is extremely important for a person's emotional and mental growth.

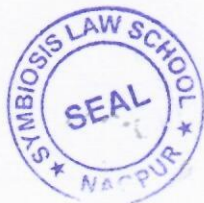
4. The best painting was submitted by Shashwati Chowdhury (First Year student)




5. Best Essay were submitted by Ms Pranjal Pagaria, First year (BA LLB) & Ms. Khushi Soi
