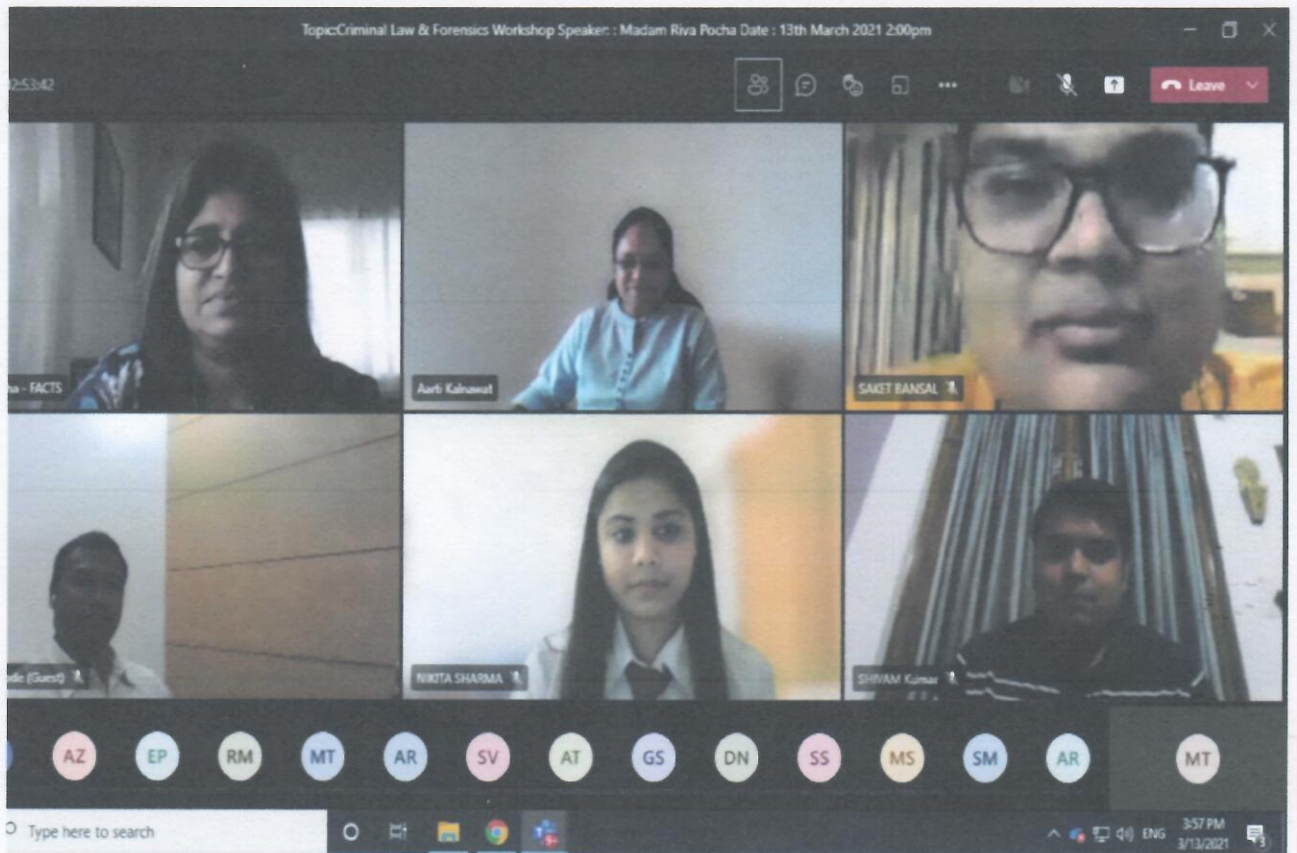
### **CRIMINAL LAW & FORENSICS WORKSHOP**

Symbiosis Law school Nagpur organised a workshop on Criminal Law & Forensics, on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2021 from 02.00pm to 04.00pm. Continuing the tradition of bringing out the best in Students in terms of subject knowledge, Dr. Sukhvinder Singh Dari, Director of Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur, in his Welcome Address accentuated the importance of forensic science with criminal law investigation and showed his inclination towards organising such practical based training as an intrinsic part of student's all round development. While addressing, he stressed on the importance of linkage between the criminal law & forensics. He also thanked the participants for attending the workshop.
