



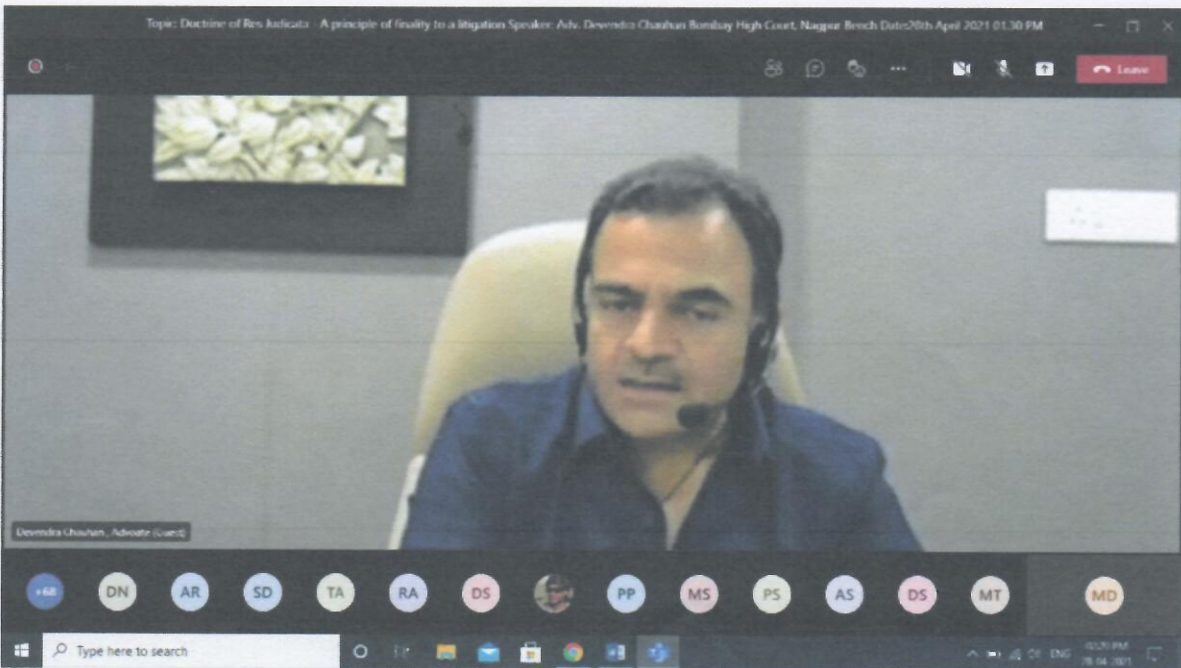
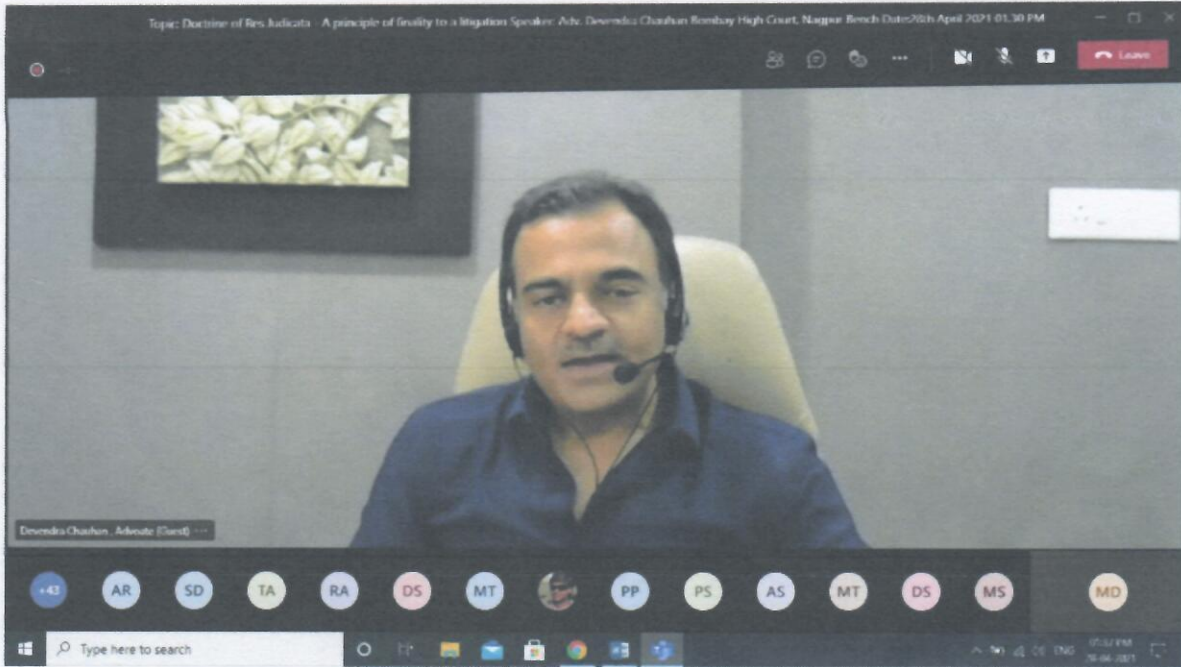

Doctrine of Res judicata - A principle of finality to a litigation
