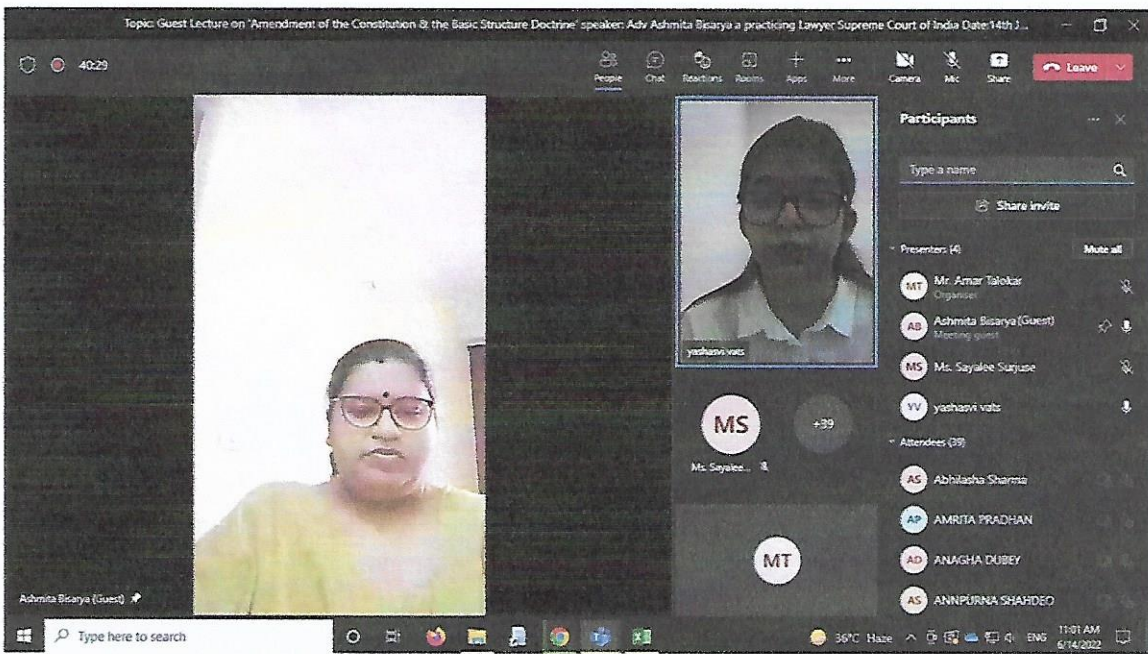
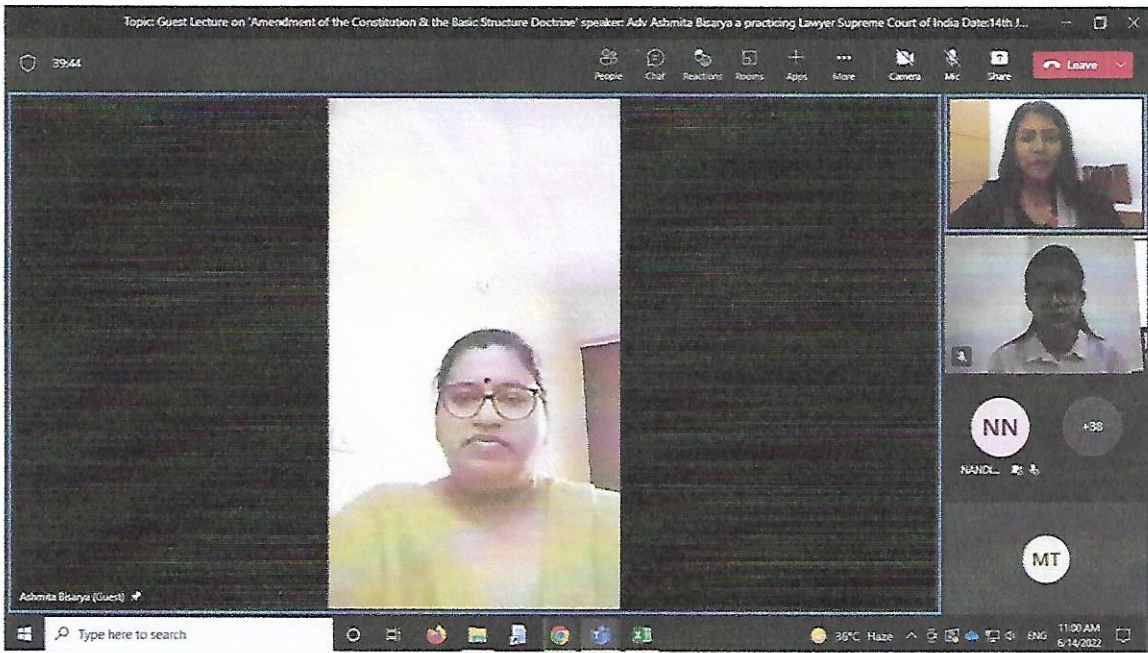
GUEST LECTURE ON 'AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION & THE BASIC STRUCTURE DOCTRINE'

Held on 14th June 2022

Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur organized a Guest Lecture on 'Amendment of the Constitution and the Basic Structure Doctrine' on the 14th of June 2022 for the students of BA & BBA LL.B. of 2021-26 batch. The lecture was organized with the objective of giving a detailed insight to the students on the Amendment of the Constitution which is an integral part of the Course – Constitutional Law I. Adv. Ashmita Bisarya, a practicing lawyer before the Supreme Court of India was the resource person for the Lecture. The program began at 11:00 am with Ms. Sayalee Surjuse, course in charge, and Assistant Professor, Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur welcoming the guest.

Adv. Ashmita Bisarya informed the students about the Procedure of amendment of the Constitution, the amending power of the Parliament, and the genesis of the Basic Structure Doctrine. She explained in detail the constituent power of the parliament for amending the Constitution through the textual provision. She used many examples in the form of cases to trace the origin and evolution of the Basic Structure Doctrine by the Supreme Court of India.

This was followed by a question-answer session where Adv. Bisarya very enthusiastically answered the queries posed by the students. Ms. Yashasvi Vats, a student of Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur moderated the program and delivered the vote of thanks. The lecture was attended by approximately 100 students.
