Prof. (Dr.) Poonam Pradhan Saxena, Vice-Chancellor of National Law University Jodhpur was the Chief Guest and the Prof. (Dr.) Tarun Arora Dean, School of Law Central University of Punjab was the Guest of Honor. The Master of the Ceremony, Dr. Deepti Khubalkar, Faculty at Symbiosis Law School (SLS), Nagpur began the ceremony by welcoming the Chief Guest, Guest of Honor, the Director, the students and the other participants in the audience. A short film on how Symbiosis came into being was featured.

This feature was followed by the Welcome address and introductory remark by Dr. Sukhvinder Singh Dari, Director, Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur. Dr. Dari in his welcome address emphasized on the importance of one year LL.M course and quality education at Symbiosis Law School and urged the new young professionals to inculcate the same legacy. He stressed on the importance of research and declared that there will be a series of programmes which are planned for them to impart better understanding about the subjects. Dr. Sachin Tripathi also explained the details regarding examinations and evaluation methods of compulsory and elective courses as well as dissertation.

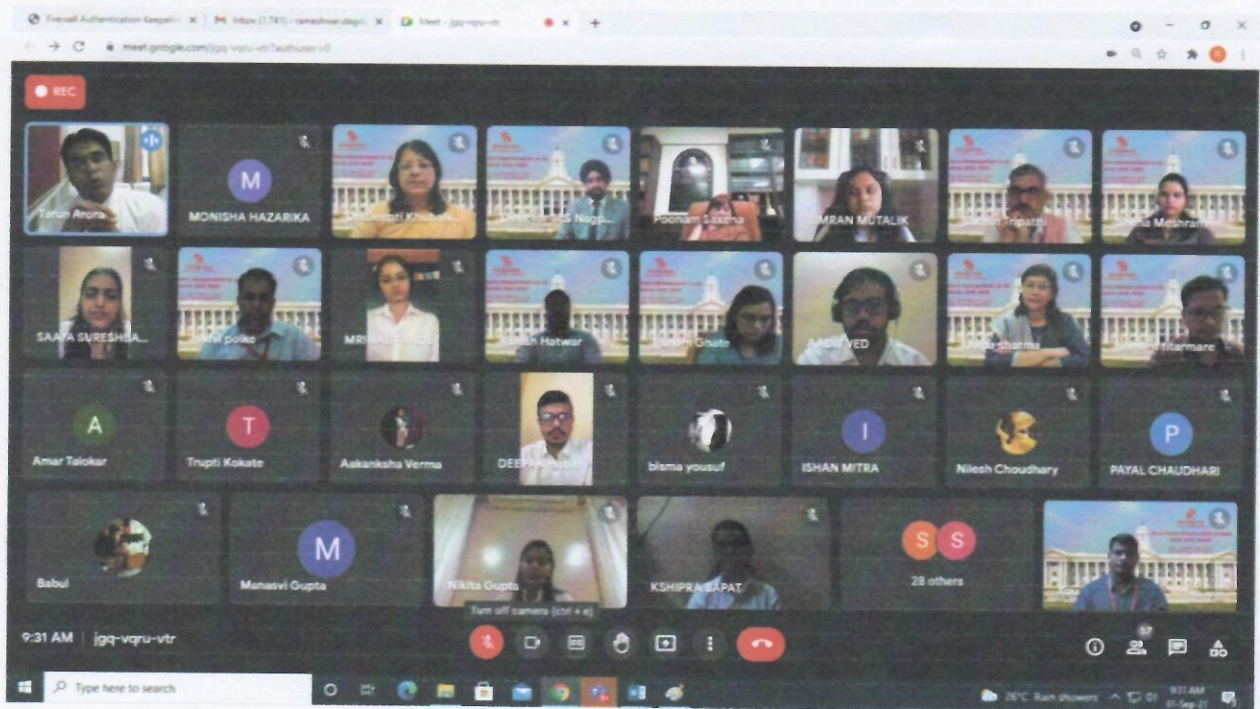

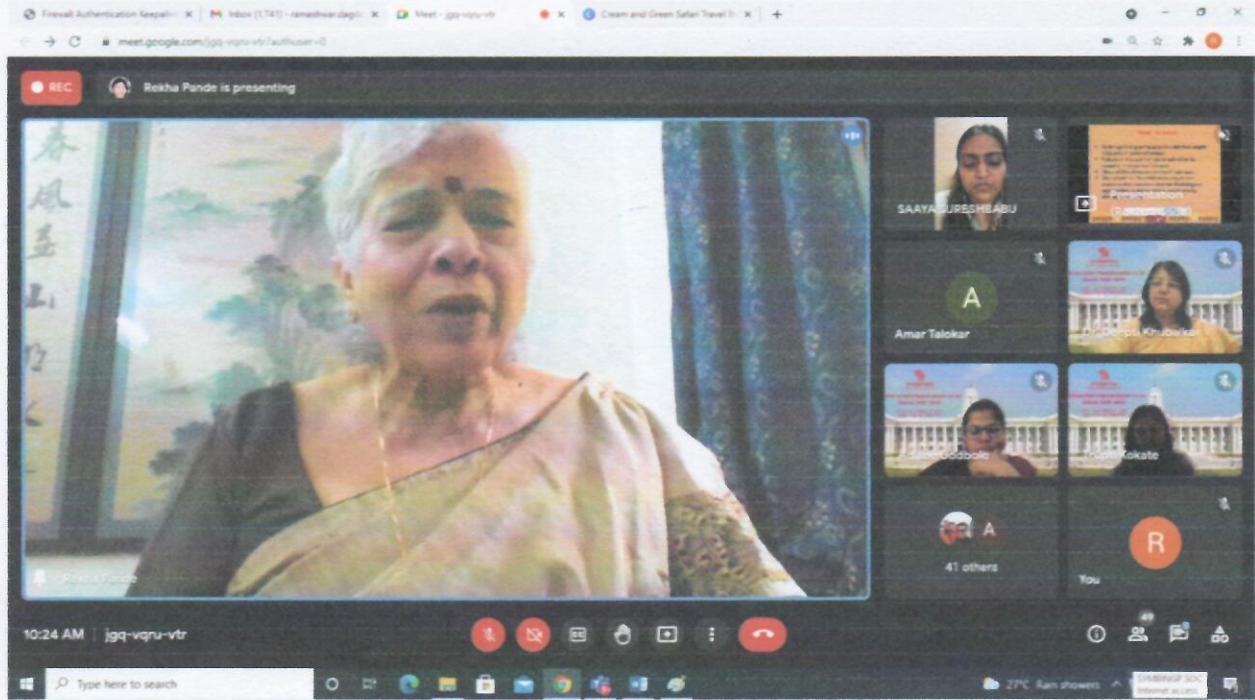
