The Centre for Environmental Law and Policy at Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur announces its Third National Essay Writing Competition on the topic "Energy Law and Policy in India".

### Sub-themes

- Access to Clean Energy in India: Issues and Challenges.
- Policy and Regulatory Framework for Nuclear Energy in India: The way forward.
- Renewable Energy Resources as Means to Combat Global Warming in India.
- The intersection between Human Rights Violations and Renewable Energy in India: Gaps and Measures.
- Coal Extraction in India and Legal Framework on Mining: An introspection.

### Eligibility Criteria

The competition is open to students who are pursuing their five-year integrated course of Law/LL.B./LL.M./Ph.D./M.Phil. or any other undergraduate/ post-graduate/ doctoral course (other than Law) in any university across the India.

### **Guidelines for Submission**

- 2. The participants must upload a scanned copy of their students Identity Card/bonafide certificate establishing the affiliation to the institution under the signature and seal of the Head of the Institution.
- 3. The essays must be submitted in English language only and must be in Microsoft Word Format (.doc/.docx). Essays in any other language and format will be rejected summarily.
- 4. Only one submission per author is permitted. Co-authorship is permitted to a maximum of two authors per essay.
- 5. All entries should include a cover page specifying name of the author, institutional affiliation, course and year of study, e-mail address and contact number.

- 6. Any identifying information should not be mentioned anywhere in the text of the essay and violation of the same shall lead to immediate disqualification.
- 7. Paper must be original and unpublished work of the authors. The paper should not be under consideration for publication or in a contest elsewhere.
- 8. The essays will be put through a Plagiarism test and further assessed by a Jury. Plagiarism of any nature will attract immediate disqualification.
- 9. The suggested word limit for the essay is 4000 words inclusive of citations.
- 10. The submission of the essay must be in a single .doc/.docx format file that shall contain an abstract, essay and bibliography.
- 11. The length of the abstract should not be more than 250 words including the title and the key words.
- 12. The footnotes must confirm to authoritative standard rule of citation.

### Formatting Guidelines

- Font :- Times New Roman,
- Font Size-12,
- Line Spacing-1.5, and Justified.
- The footnotes must be typed in Times New Roman, Font Size-10 and Line Spacing-1.
- The margins should be 1 inch or 2.54 cm on all sides.

- 1. There is no hard copy submission.
- 2. The participants(s) shall register and submit the essays through the following link:
