Date: 8th April, 2022

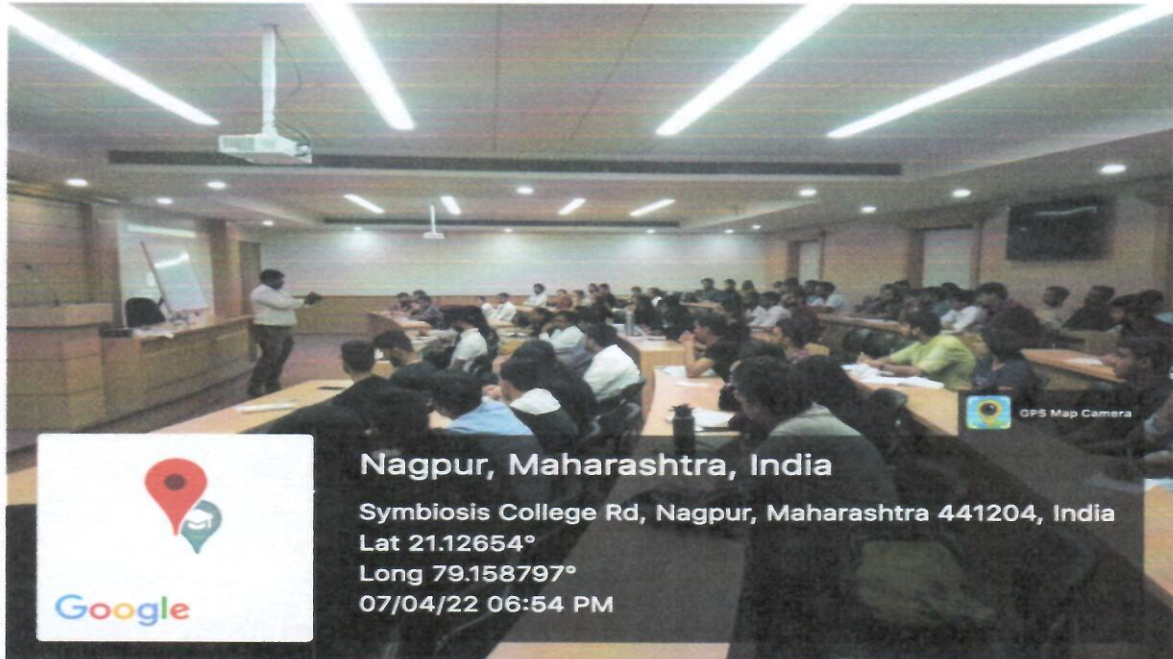

The workshop was conducted by **Dr. Rengasamy Stalin** who is an Assistant Registrar (Academics) at Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur. He in his impeccable style started discussing with students that in forensic science, **questioned document examination (QDE) is the examination of documents potentially disputed in a court of law**. Its primary purpose is to provide evidence about a suspicious or questionable document using scientific processes and methods. He gave some sugar to students and asked them to identify two similar piece of sugar and made some students as expert to verify the same. He highlighted to students that no piece of sugar will have the same identity as all have their individuality.

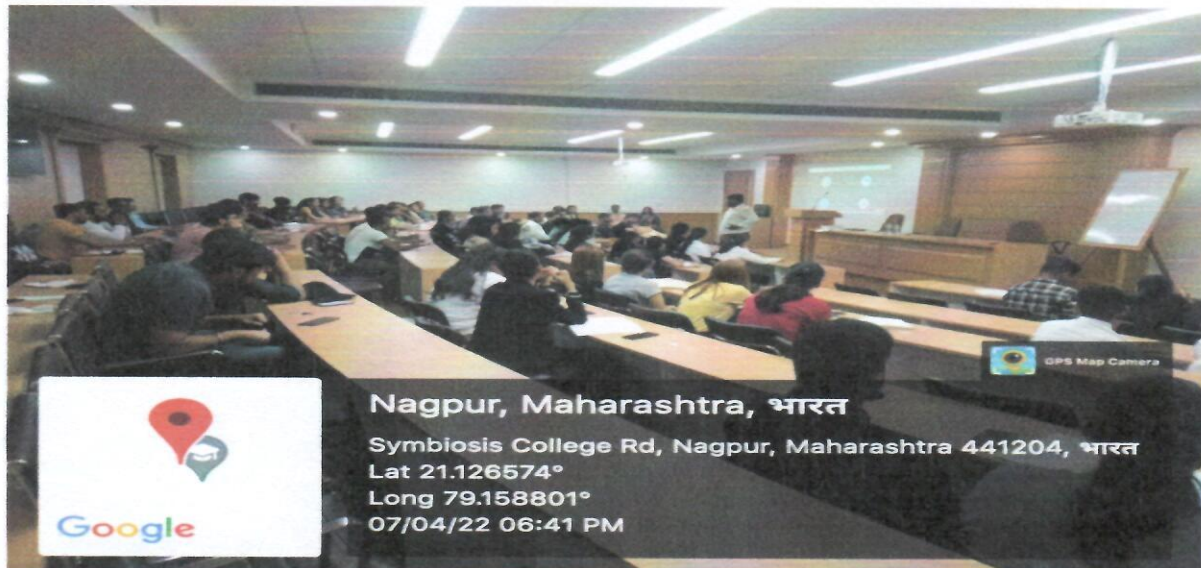
On the next day of his address, he focused on **handwriting analysis** and discussed that most familiar area of questioned-document examination is handwriting analysis. Here the examiner is called upon to determine if a particular person was the author of a document.

The examiner compares characteristics of the questioned document with those of a document either previously written by the suspect or purposely taken as a known handwriting sample, also called an exemplar.

The two days' workshop prove to be very beneficial for more than 100 students in hybrid mode and they enjoyed the session thoroughly.




Dr. Rengasamy Stalin addressing the students.
