4TH INTERNAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION- 2023

Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur conducted its Fourth Internal Moot Court Competition on 11th March, 2023. The competition was open for participation from three batches of students hailing from the second, third and fourth year at Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur. The moot proposition was based on Criminal Law. The participants were given the liberty to form a team comprising of three members. The participants were given one month for preparing their respective written submissions and oral arguments. The judging criterion for teams was two-fold and was based on their written memorial submissions along with their advocacy skills in oral rounds.

The competition saw an overwhelming participation from 84 teams. The competition was adjudged by a panel of distinguished judges which comprised of eminent lawyers and the faculty of the college. The judges were impressed by the performance of teams and commended the teams for their hard-work and exposition. The competition was a great learning experience for all the participants. It enabled the students to indulge in an authentic simulation of an actual court with an aim to hone their advocacy skills. The competition reached its feat of refining the crucial qualities that are needed in the legal field like researching, drafting and presenting arguments through this endeavour.

After the oral round for the competition was concluded, the Moot Court Association of Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur released a merit list nominating the teams on the basis of their absolute ranks. **Team no. 21** comprising of Bisweswar Bhowmik, Krishnav Gogoi and Soumyajoti Lodh was declared winner of the competition, while **team no. 35** comprising of Seshadri Gautam Mahabhashyam C.S. Ajay Balaji and Meka Bhanu Lakshmi Hasmitha and **team no. 103** comprising of Ishita Sinha, Raghav Pareek and Ritwik Singh backed the second and third place respectively. 
