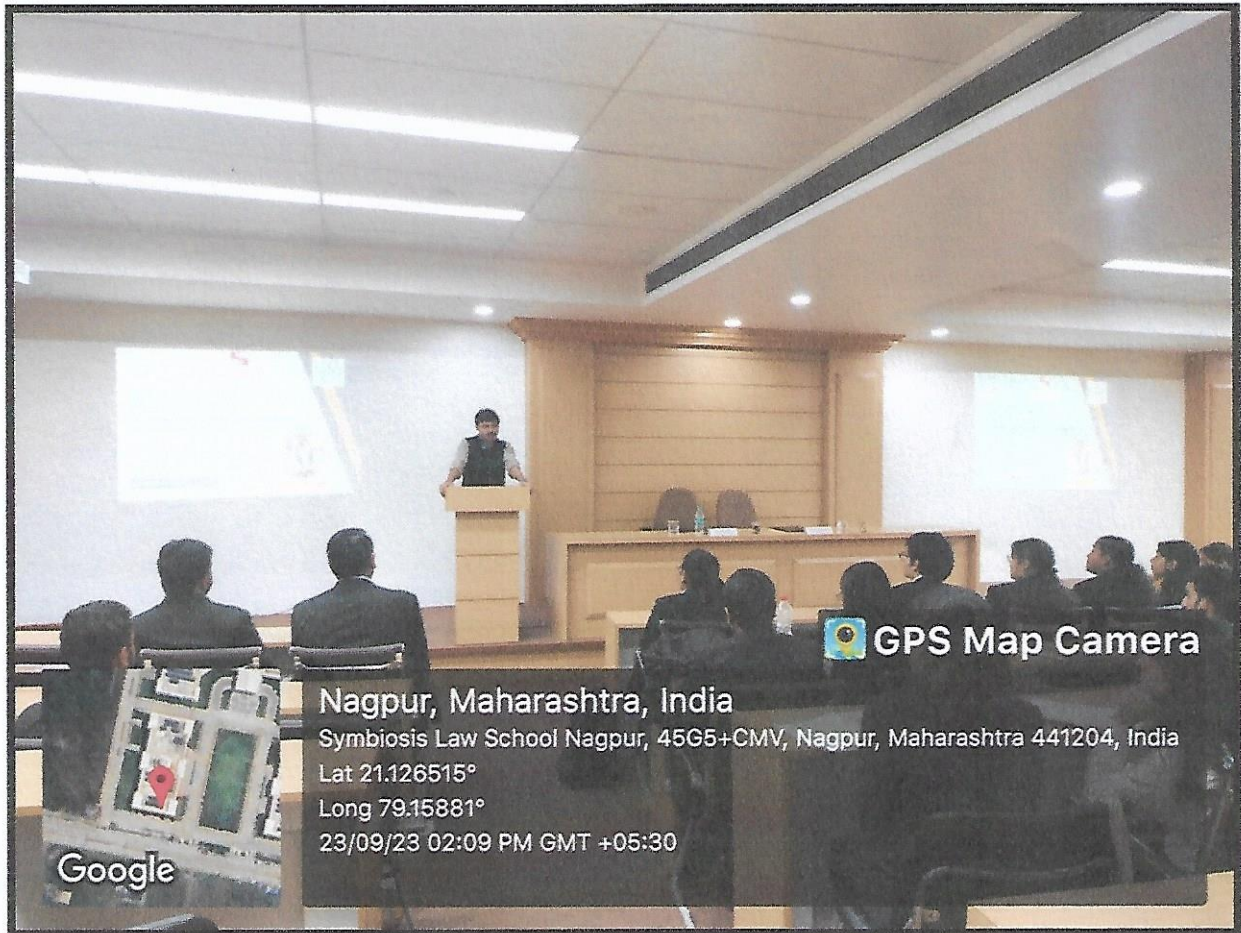

Adv Saxena discussed the components/essentials in both Civil and Criminal judgment namely jurisdiction, cause title, name of the court delivering the judgment, date of judgment, facts of the case, in criminal case judgments the charges and types of witnesses, followed by analysis or reasoning.

Adv. Saxena briefed about the difference between Code and Act, types of witnesses, objectives behind punishments, types of examinations etc. Through specific sections of Cr.P.C and C.P.C, he explained various important components and aspects of a Judgment.

The resource person also discussed about the impact or influence of media reports on the judges and judgments. The workshop was interactive and insightful. Various questions were posed
