Guest Lecture on How to draft Caveat Application

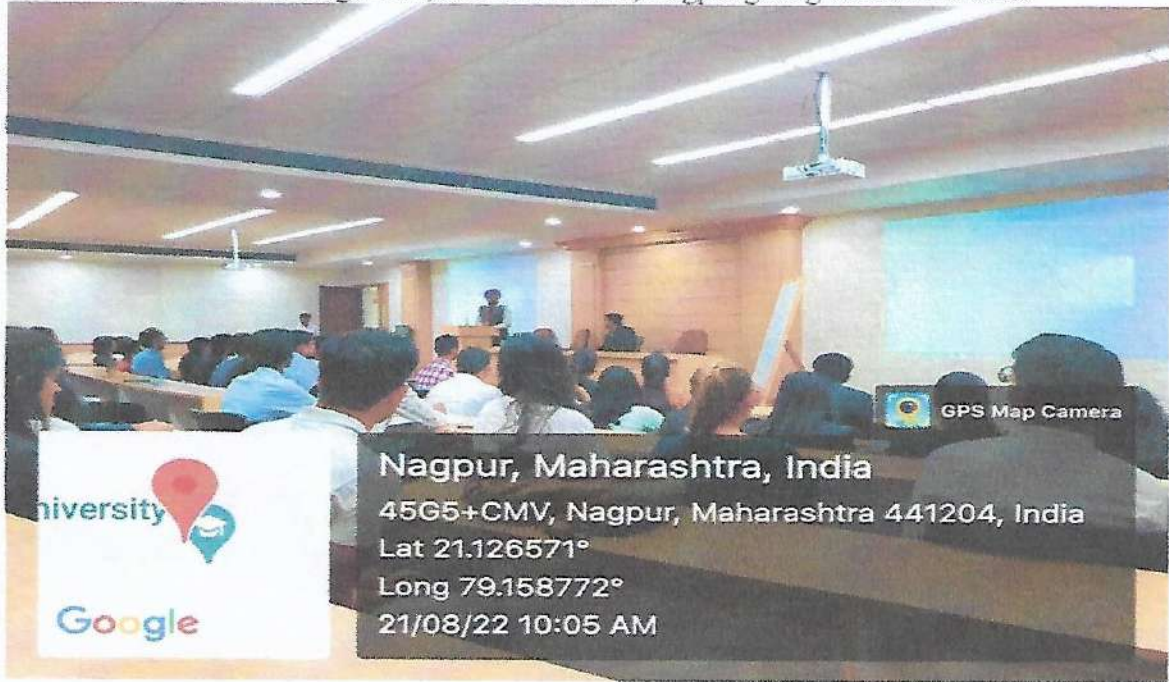
On 21st August 2022, SLS Nagpur invited Adv. Rahul Kalangiwale, a practising Advocate at the Bombay High Court, Nagpur Bench as the resource person to grace the Lecture Series. In his Welcome Address, Dr Sukhvinder Singh Dari, Director of Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur emphasized the necessity of learning textual legal knowledge and applying it in the real legal world. During the lecture, the resource person provided an overview on how to draft a Caveat Application, as well as the form, particulars and structure of a Caveat Application, using live examples.

The session began at 10:00 a.m. sharp, where Adv. Rahul covered Section 148-A the important provision of the Civil Procedure Code. In his address, he explained that the provision of Caveat is a right given to a person in civil proceedings to avoid ex-parte orders or judgments. He also covered various sub-topics like What is a Caveat ?, Rights to lodge a Caveat, Who may lodge a Caveat, Notice, Rights and Duties of the Caveator and the bar of limitation on the Caveat application. He gave all the important tips relating procedure of filing the original Caveat and Appeal of the order passed by courts under the said provision.

The session ended with the vote of thanks which was proposed by Sanskruti Bhoir, a member of SCASL. It was an overall fruitful and resourceful session in the form of a Lecture series which received a huge response and wonderful feedback from the students of SLS Nagpur.
