Guest Lecture on How to Approach Consumer Forum

In order to achieve technical assistance and capacity-building support in areas of Advocacy and organizational development and as part of its ongoing efforts, Symbiosis Centre for Advocacy Skills and Litigation (SCASL) under Symbiosis Law school-Nagpur launched a Lecture series on Advocacy Skills. This lecture series aims at helping and creating skills in its students, for effective writing, persuasive and confident presentation, and the ability to anticipate an opponent's arguments, which are valuable skills to have, regardless of the career path, a student chooses.

This series is an initiative by Dr. Sukhvinder Singh Dari, Director of Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur and our faculty in-charge Dr Deepti Khubalkar, Faculty at SLS, Nagpur to give a holistic growth to the student in various areas of law which are difficult to be covered in an academic curriculum. The main aim of these guest Lecture series is to educate the students on the techniques which are truly required for practical knowledge of an Advocate.

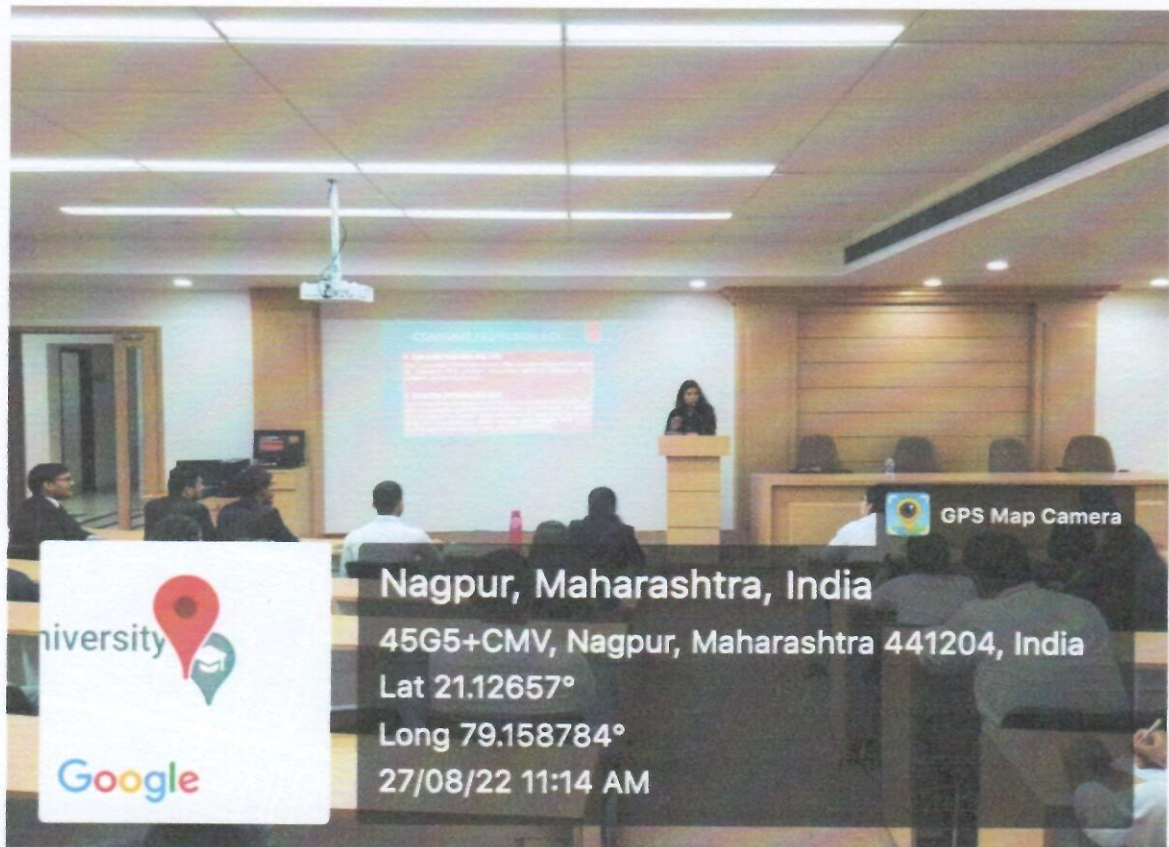
On 27th August 2022, SLS Nagpur invited Adv. Dishaa Khandelwal as the resource person to grace the Lecture Series. She is a legal practitioner with experience in litigation along with drafting and managing contracts, agreements, deeds, correspondences, and other documents. She was part of the chambers of Adv. Ghate & Associates till 2021. Presently she is working as an associate in Khandelwal and Associates and handling litigations before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Nagpur Bench, and other tribunals. The welcome address was given by Ms. Bhumi Sharma, member of SCASL and student at SLS-Nagpur. During the lecture, the resource person provided an overview on how to draft a Caveat Application, as well as the form, particulars and structure of a Caveat Application, using live examples.

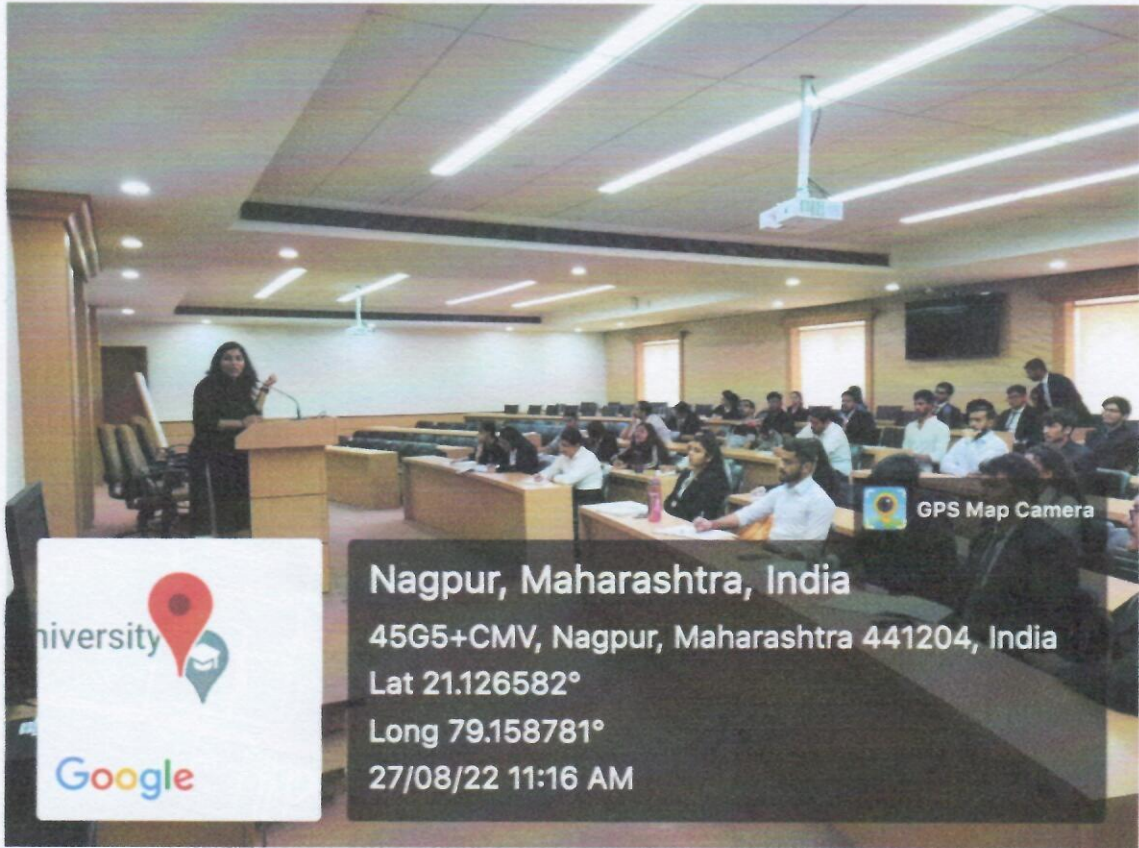
The session began at 11:30 a.m. sharp, where Adv. Dishaa started with a brief on Consumer Protection Commission Act, 1986 which was repealed and CPA, 2019 which came up with new rules and regulations. CPA, 2019, broadened the view of CPA, 1986 which was inclusive of E commerce, Direct selling, Establishment

of the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA). Further, she covered Section 2(7) of CPA, 2019 an essential part which defines who are consumers ?, Section 2(11) Deficiency in Service, Section 2 (46) Unfair Contract, and Section 2 (47) Trade Practice. In continuation she added what are consumer rights, advantages, changes incorporated and essential provisions under Consumer Protection Act, 2019, and exhaustively covering on the procedure of approaching a District/State/National Consumer Commission.

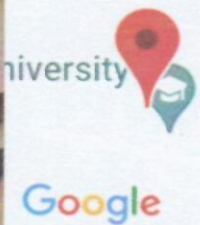
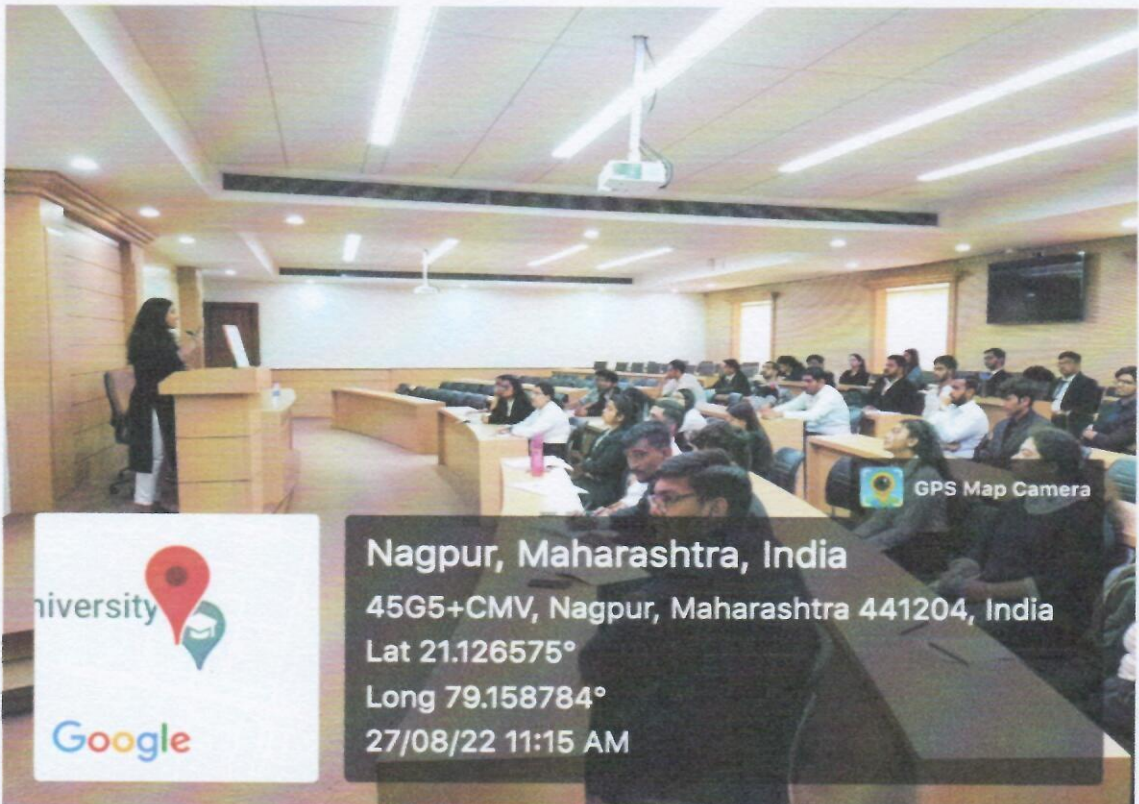
