Interactive Session on Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights

Centre for Intellectual Property Rights and Advocacy, Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur organized a one-day **interactive session on Introduction to Intellectual Property Rights** on **28th September, 2022** at Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur. The purpose of the organizing of such event was to introduce first and second year students about the basics of Intellectual Property Rights.

The workshop started with the centre's student In-charge, Aman Arora addressing the students with a basic talk about Intellectual Property Rights for which he used two video clips related to IPR, after this, the session was carried on by our very own Asst. Professor Karun Sanjaya who, with his in-depth knowledge on intellectual property rights gave an intricate introduction of the field of law, to the students.
