Symbiosis law school, Nagpur had hosted a lecture on the "Role of Forensic Science in Legal Pedagogy." The lectures were aimed at facilitating and sharing their expertise and experience by Legal Professionals. The Symbiosis Centre for Criminology & Forensic Sciences organized a guest lecture series in this regard so that students can understand the intricacies & nuances of Forensic Science as a subject from a legal perspective. The resource person for the lecture were Dr. Ashish D. Badiye, Head of Department & Assistant Professor, Government Institute of Forensic Science, Nagpur and Dr. Neeti S. Kapoor, Assistant Professor (Forensic Science), Government Institute of Forensic Science, Nagpur. The guest was welcomed and felicitate by Dr. Deepti Khubalkar, (Senior Faculty) & Prof. Himanshi Bhatia (Assistant Professor), Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur.

The lecture was conducted for two days- 24th March, 2023 (Friday) from 2:00 - 5:00 PM and on 25th March, 2023 (Saturday) from 1:00 - 6:00 PM. The topic that was covered by Dr. Neeti Kapoor on the 1st day that was- Questioned Documents- Handwriting analysis, role of handwriting expert (Private and Government), counterfeit notes, e-signature. The topics that was covered by Dr. Ashish Badiye on the 1st day of the lecture was Medico-Legal Aspects of Death, Importance of Brain Stem Death, Asphyxia, Post-mortem Examination.

A brief Question and Answer session followed after the completion of the lecture on the 1st day. Students posted their doubts quite enthusiastically which were replied by both Dr. Neeti Kapoor and Dr. Ashish Badiye.

The second day of the event began 1:00 pm. The guests were received by the senior faculty Dr. Aarti Kalnawat. The lectures that were held on this day covered the topics that were-by Dr. Ashish Badiye was Skeletal System of Humans, Skeletal Remains Identity, Superimposition Technique and Forensic Dentistry.

This was followed by Dr. Neeti Kapoor topic that was Toxicology- Concept and Scope of Toxicology; Poisons and Routes of Administration, Action of Poisons, Routes of Elimination; Legal Aspects of Poisoning; Alcohol and Narcotic.


