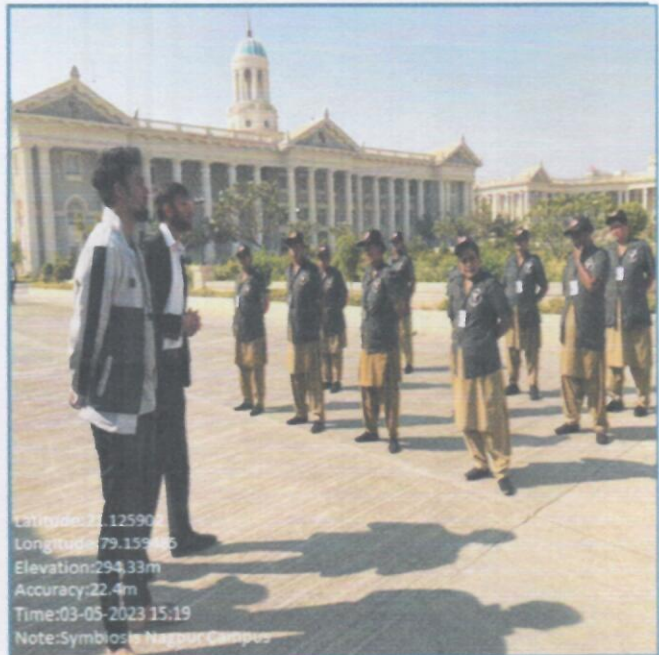
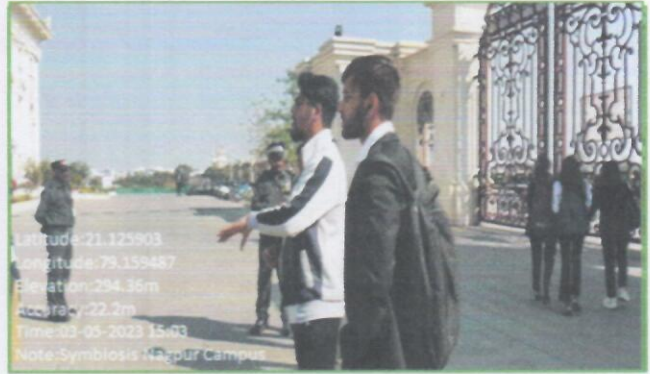
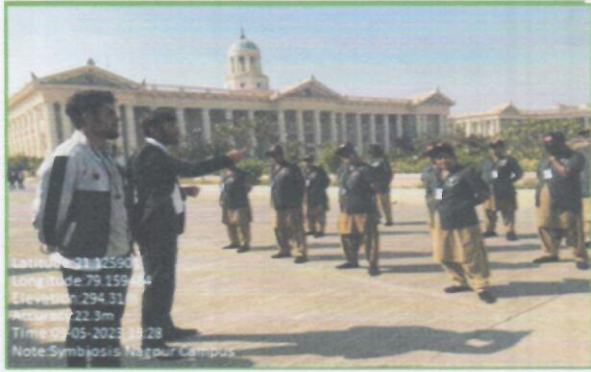

The Ayushman Bharat Scheme, also known as the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY), is a government-run health insurance scheme that provides financial protection to poor and vulnerable families in India. The Legal Aid Centre and its members, Mr. Abhinav Jindal and Saunak Biwas initiated an awareness campaign about the Ayushman Bharat Scheme in his local community.
