## Report on 1<sup>st</sup> Eco-Quiz Competition On 04<sup>th</sup> & 06<sup>th</sup> October, 2023

Eco-Quiz Competition divided into two rounds i.e. – Round 1 – Preliminary Round and Round 2 – Final Round.

Eco-Quiz Competition is about answering the questions with combination of Environmental law, Landmarks cases on Wildlife Conservation and Current Events.

Round 1 – Preliminary Round on 04<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 in Assembly Hall, consist of Pen and paper with 30 questions in 30 minutes, and Participants should participate in pair (2 Students), reposting time for the competition is 4:15 PM and all the cell members and Student- In charge started competition with short briefing by our Cell Faculty In-charge Dr. Sachin Tripathi Sir, this event successfully completed with announcing of top 5 teams qualified for Round 2 – Final Round.

Round 2 – Final Round on 06<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 in Moot Court Hall, consist of Oral round with 4 sub-rounds i.e. Statue Round, Precedent Round, Audio-Visual Round, Current Affairs [Wild Life Conservation], First Two questions in each round will be the specific questions to the individual teams. In case the team fails to answer then it will be passing over to the other teams through Buzzer. Time allotted for each question is 30 seconds. Competition started at 4:30 PM with 15 minutes briefing by our Cell Faculty In-charge and Moot Master for this Competition Dr. Sachin Tripathi Sir.
