### **WORKSHOP ON 'THE ART OF WRITING A RESEARCH PAPER'**

**HELD ON 17<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2022**

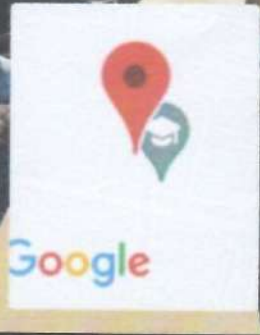
The Research & Publication Cell of Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur organized a One - Day Workshop titled 'The Art of Writing a Research Paper' on the 17<sup>th</sup> of September 2022 for the students of BA and BBA LL.B. of all the batches. Doing constructive research is an essential element of every lawyer's tool kit. However, researching and writing a research paper is an art that requires channelized guidance. The workshop was organized with the objective of giving hands-on training to the students for undertaking legal research and reducing the same in writing. The workshop was divided into two sessions for the day. For this purpose, we invited Dr. Rupal Rautdesai, visiting faculty at Symbiosis Law School, Pune, and Adv. Namit Saxena, Advocate on Record, Supreme Court of India to address the students. The Workshop started with the welcome address by Dr. Sukhvinder Singh Dari, Director, Symbiosis Law School, Nagpur followed by felicitation of the guests.

Dr. Rupal Rautdesai was the resource person for the first session of the day. She addressed the students on '*Basics of Research Methodology*'. Madam dealt with the preliminary requirements to be adhered to while doing research and while writing a research paper. She also informed the students about certain ideas which will be useful for honing their research skills. Madam also explained the basics of Doctrinal Legal Research and Empirical Legal Research. This was followed by a question-answer session where she very enthusiastically answered the queries posed by the students. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Ms. Pragya Sinha, a student-member of the Research and Publication cell.

Adv. Namit Saxena, Advocate on Record, Supreme Court of India was the resource person for the second session of the day. Sir spoke on the topic '*Legal Research*'. He shared with the student's areas of law that can be explored further. Sir put it in perspective how this type of legal research has the potential for laying down the foundation for policy making and also for providing insights into judicial decision-making. This was followed by a question-answer session. Sir, answered the questions to the satisfaction of the students.
