“Workshop on How to Draft a Complaint & Writ Petition” 01 October 2022

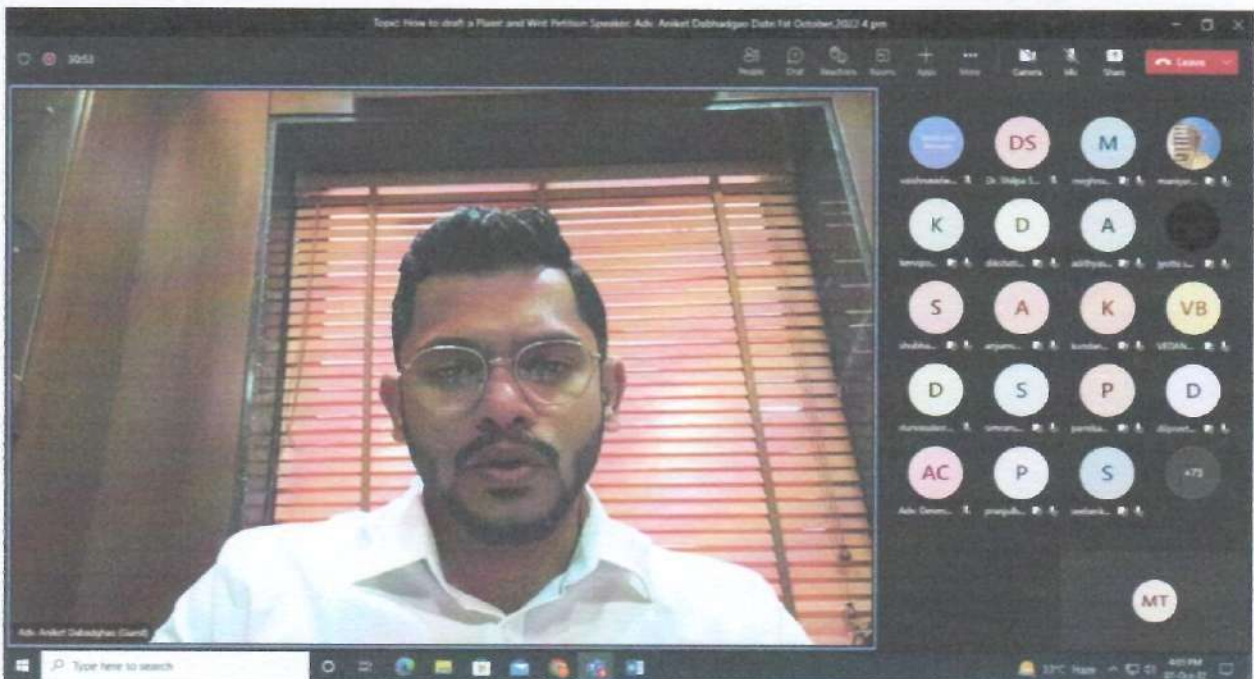
In the first session, Adv. Dabadghao informed the students about the skills of legal drafting. He dealt with the relevant provisions of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 which are essential for the drafting of a Complaint. He dealt with the various steps to be borne in mind while drafting a Complaint in a nuanced manner. At the same time, he also informed the students that drafting is an art that is to be mastered over a period of time.

In the second part of the session Adv. Dabadghao spoke to the students about the drafting of the Writ Petition. He gave valuable insights to the students on how to draft a Writ Petition. He referred to the relevant provision of the law which should be kept in mind while drafting. He used a copy of the Complaint and Writ Petition to demonstrate which made the session very lively, interactive and easy to follow.
